The 2017 IEEE International Pulsed Power Conference Proceedings will be published on DVD and on IEEE Xplore. All manuscripts must be submitted electronically by Monday, July 31, 2017 and follow the IEEE conference paper format (<http://ece-events.unm.edu/ppc2017/MSStemplate.html>)

The submission website will be the same as that used for abstract submission.

Papers submitted may include color material, but must still be legible in black and white.

Normal papers are limited to 4 pages. Invited Talks are allowed 6 pages. Plenary Talks are allowed 8 pages.

At least one author must have been registered for the conference.


The paper must have been presented at the conference.

The paper must not appear elsewhere on IEEE Xplore. All papers will be submitted to the CrossCheck system prior to peer review.



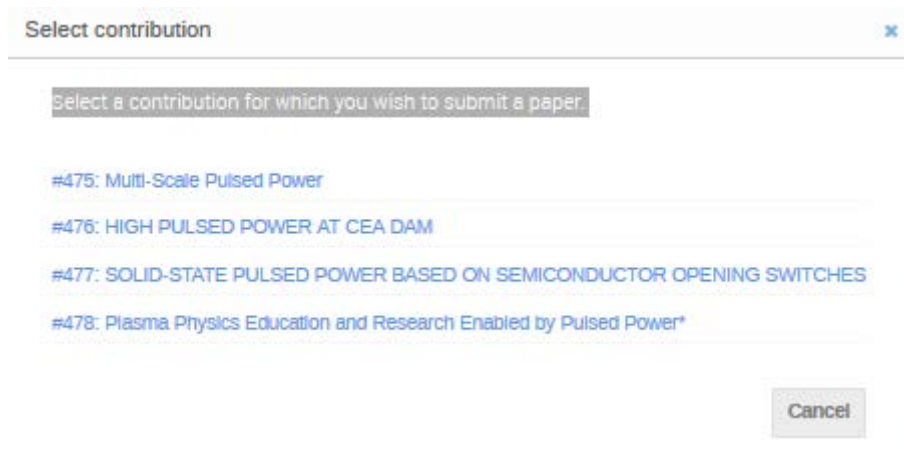

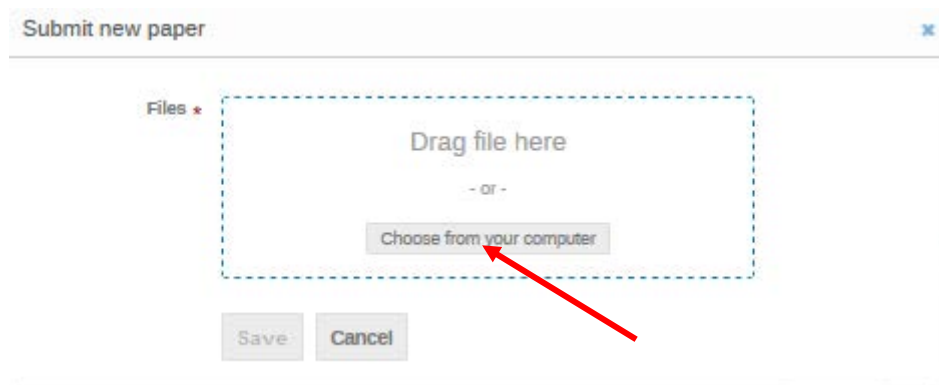
